Rules of Procedure of the Futuristic Security Council

A. General Rules

Rule 1 - Scope : These Rules of Procedure apply to the crisis committee of Futuristic UNSC. This document will be used as the main set of rules unless stated otherwise or the Secretariat permits otherwise. The Secretariat and Academic Team shall anytime modify these rules in accordance to committee's and academic flow's demands.

Rule 2 - Language : Official working language of Futuristic USNC and of the documents produced within the committee are English.

Rule 3 - Dress Code : The official dress code of the conference is western business attire. Delegates are allowed to dress in national or traditional attire only with permission from the Secretariat.

Rule 4 - Electronics : Electronic devices are not allowed to be used in the Committees during moderated caucuses and all devices are allowed during unmoderated caucuses. The Academic Team of the committee will provide you a google drive file for you to write all of your documents in it. You can also write your documents by hand though, usage of this google drive file will be preferred by the academic team.

B. Committee Proceedings

Rule 5 - Agenda : Futuristic UNSC has an open agenda policy, delegates of the committee or free to start whichever topic they feel is the most important from the study guide and the timeline.

Rule 6 - Members : Voting rights for the members of the council has been explained in the study guide in section “The New United Nations Security Council”. You can find all the changes and the continuing rules of the council in the mentioned section of the study guide.

Rule 7 - Form of Debate : The Futuristic UNSC shall have the following types of debate, which require a simple majority of the members to pass. The FUNSC will follow the normal form of debates of the UNSC with the addition of :

- I. **Semi Moderated Caucus** - Semi-moderated caucus is proposed when members of the Council are faced with a crisis situation which needs to be answered quickly. Semi moderated caucuses shall be proposed with a maximum total time of 20 minutes and no individual time limitations. Moderator can terminate a debate on discretion, or put an end to a speech if he/ she feels necessary to do so, and these discretions are not subject to appeal.
- II. **Tour de Table** – This debate form will require that every member of the Council shall make a speech regarding the specified topic. The duration of the speeches is 60 seconds for each member of the council.

Rule 8 - Points : The Council will follow all the known points in a general assembly of a normal UNSC.

Rule 9 - Motions : Motion for a semi moderated or unmoderated shall be proposed for the purposes explained above in section B. Rule 7.

- I. **Motion for Suspension:** Motion for the suspension of the meeting shall be proposed by the end of the session as scheduled by ACUMUN 2020.
- II. **Motion for Adjournment:** Motion for the adjournment of the meeting shall be proposed by the end of the conference as scheduled by ACUMUN 2020.

Rule 10 - Voting Procedure : Closure of debate motion will not be entertained in order to vote on a document. Any document that requires voting by all committee shall be subject to a special set of rules.

In order to proceed to voting on the document “Motion to Move to Vote on [Document Name]” shall be in order. When this motion is entertained, voting will be conducted by placard. Other proposals for voting are out of order.

C. Documents

Rule 11 - Documents : The council will follow the normal documentation of a UNSC committee, in addition to those the Council shall have the following documents :

- I. Press Release :** are for to give a quick answer to the world media for the situation that the council is given at the time. For the press release to be introduced, all members of the council needs to be a signatory of the press release.
- II. Governmental Directive :** These directives secret directives of each member of the council. The directives directly goes to the academic team of the committee who will be acting is the government of the member who sends the directive. These directives are for the communication line between the members in the council and their government which ever brand that they need to contact or get information from on a specific matter.
- III. Informational Directive :** Members of the council are allowed to ask questions about the ongoing situations around the world during 2051, or any detail they want to know between 2020 - 2051. The academic team of the committee holds the right to not give a complete answer.
